

RACING RULES

1. All Participants under 18 years of age must have a consent form signed by a parent.
2. All participants must sign a release of liability form. Proper riding gear will be required, helmet, eye protection, long sleeve shirt, pants, and shoes over the ankle any time you are on an ATV, including the race and pit area. No one under the age of 12 will be allowed to race.
3. Once racing begins, there will be no refunds.
4. All participants will be staged in the pit area by race class.
5. All classes will be called to the "on deck" area as a group.
6. Once in the "on deck" area, the starting official will call 2 machines at a time to the starting line.
7. Once a class starts to race, the "on deck" area will be closed to additional participants.
8. At the starting line, the 2 machines will begin at the starting officials command. You are required to stay in your respective lane across the log barrier, up to the mud pit. Once you have entered that area, you are allowed to work for position through a series of "s" turns. At the moguls, you are required to move back into your respective lanes across the jump and to the finish line.
9. At the finish line, you are required to come to a complete stop inside the box area marked by orange cones.
10. At the finish line, there will be an orange cone with a tennis ball on top. If you knock the tennis ball off of the cone, you will be penalized 2 seconds. If you do not come to a complete stop, you will be disqualified and escorted off of the track.
11. The timer will end your time, once you have entered the finish box completely.
12. The timer will record your time, remove the cone and you will be allowed to enter the "on deck" area for your second run.
13. For your second run, you will be positioned in the opposite lane. Your fastest time will be used.
14. After the completion of your second run, you will return to the pit area in sets of 2's.
15. All winners will be announced at the completion of tallying each class with the winners announced and presentation of trophies.
16. There will be no spectators allowed in the pit or track area. That also includes racers that are not "on deck" to race. SAFETY IS OUR PRIORITY.
17. Exhaust levels will abide by the state law of 96 decibels, or you will not be able to participate. We will perform a sound check if necessary.
18. We reserve the right to make any changes we find necessary.
