### GREEN LAKE COUNTY FAIR COMMEMORATIVE GUN RAFFLE

This year, the Green Lake County Fair will be sponsoring a very special Fair & 4-H Fundraiser. The raffle's grand prize is a Green Lake County Commemorative Rifle. Monies from this fundraiser will be used for 4-H/Fair project areas.

The Rifle is a Hartford Winchester Model 92 - 45 Long Colt made of 24kt Gold, Antique Gold, Antique Nickel, High Gloss Nickel & Black Chrome with a Walnut Display Case. Receiver artwork includes a Green Lake County map, Courthouse, Markesan Depot, Nathan Strong Park Gazebo, Princeton Brewery, golfer silhouette, walleye, Judson Tower, Chief Highnocker Tree, speedboat/sailboat, whitetail buck/lake trout with matching etchings, County Seal and the Ed Wabiszewski farm. The raffle includes two additional prizes of \$250 (cash) and \$150 (certificate) donated by Holliday Food & Sport in Ripon. The cost of a raffle ticket is \$10 with a maximum of only 2,000 tickets being sold. The drawing will be held during the Green Lake County Fair on Saturday, August 8 at 4:00 p.m. in the Entertainment Tent. Winner need not be present to win.
